and the

**German Jordanian University, represented by the President**

– hereinafter: GJU –

### § 1 Requirements for the Issuance of Certificates of Equivalence

- (1) The Accreditation Council shall determine whether the degree programs at GJU meet the formal and academic criteria specified in Parts 2 and 3 of the Model Statutes and shall certify to GJU that the criteria have been met in the respective degree program by means of a certificate of equivalence, provided that
  - a) the GJU submits to the Accreditation Council the self-evaluation report, together with its appendices, on which the evaluation was based;
  - b) it also submits an evaluation report demonstrating compliance with the aforementioned criteria;
  - c) the evaluation procedure was conducted in each case by one or more agencies approved by the Accreditation Council in accordance with Part 4 of the Model Statutes.
- (2) Self-reports and evaluation reports must be submitted to the Accreditation Council in German.
- (3) The Accreditation Council publishes the certificates of equivalence and assessment reports in the database of accredited degree programs.

### § 2 Legal Consequences

The issuance of equivalence certificates has no legal consequences. The issuance does not result in degree programs accredited with the seal of the Accreditation Council.

### § 3 Significant Changes

Significant changes to the degree programs must be reported to the Accreditation Council in a timely manner. The Accreditation Council decides on this basis whether it can maintain the certificates of equivalence.

### § 4 Costs

A fee of 350 EUR per degree program applies.

### § 5 Entry into Force and Termination

- (1) This agreement becomes effective upon signature.
- (2) In the event of a material breach of obligations under this agreement, the contracting parties reserve the right to terminate the agreement.
- (3) The university may withdraw from this agreement at any time; however, the university must reimburse the Accreditation Council for any expenses incurred.

### § 6 Final Provisions

- (1) Amendments or additions to this agreement must be in writing.
- (2) Should any provision of this agreement be or become invalid, this shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the agreement. The parties undertake to replace the provision in question with one that most closely approximates the originally intended purpose.
- (3) This contract shall be governed by German law.
- (4) The venue for all legal disputes arising from this agreement is Cologne.
