



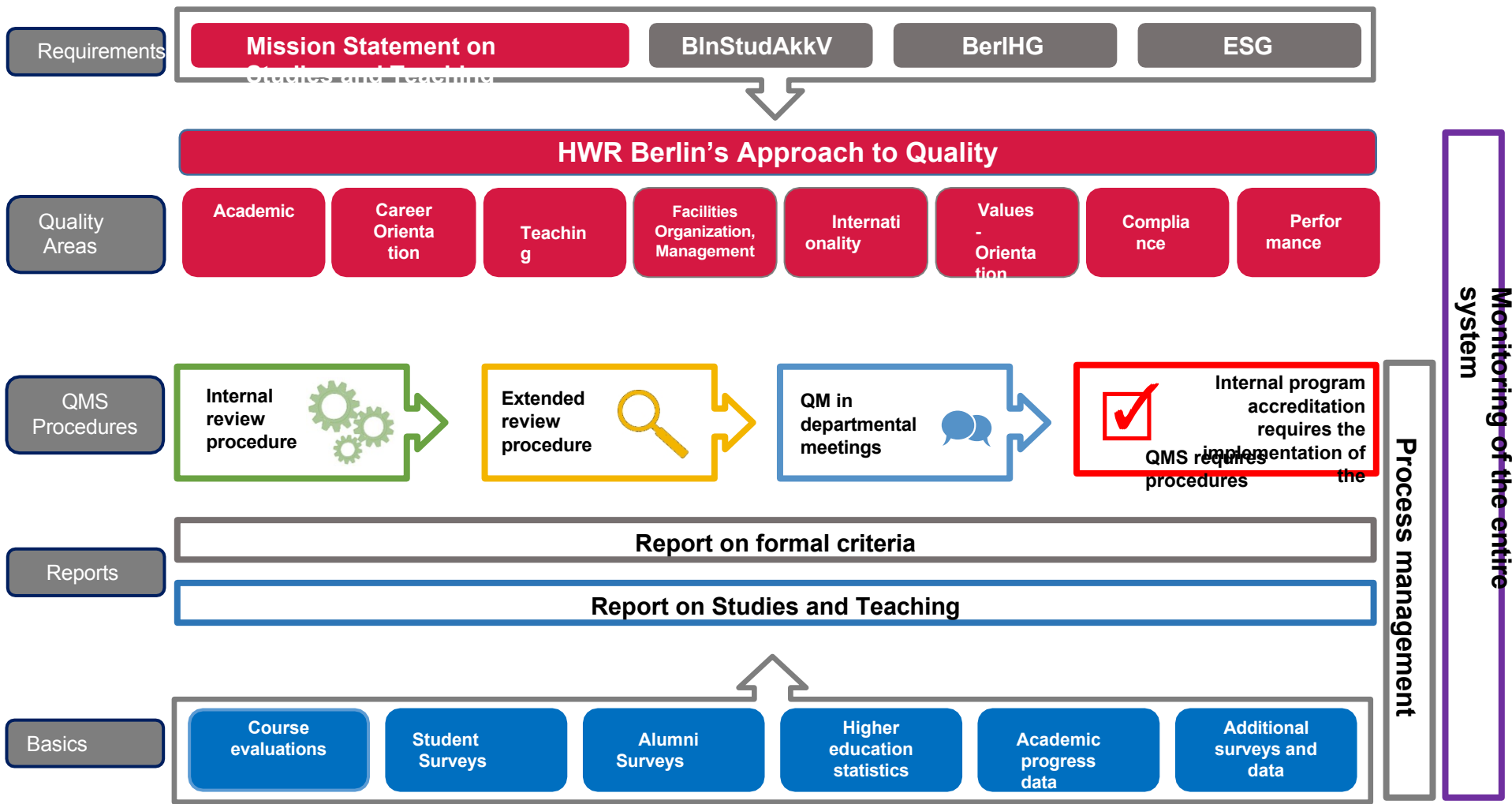

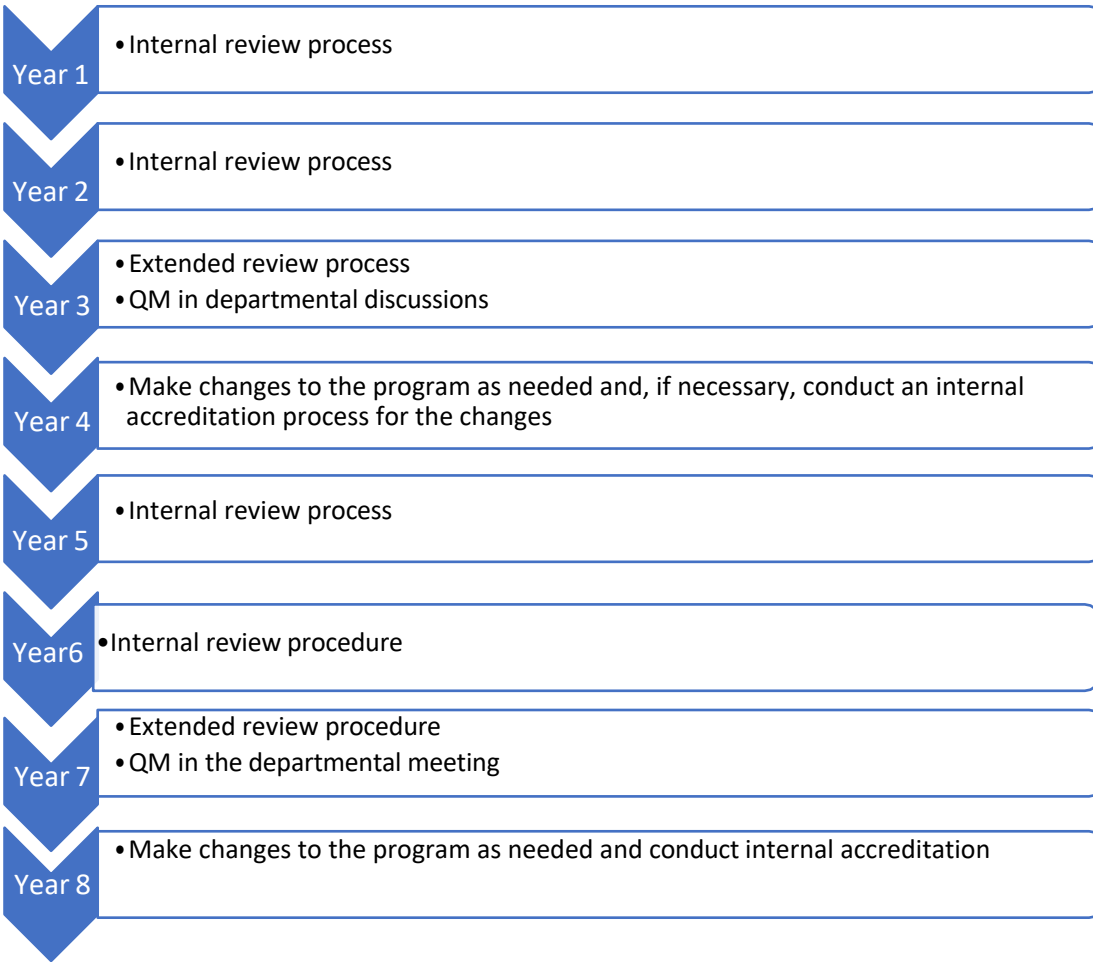

# Flexibility!

Process orientation with stratification of individual review steps

- Involvement of external parties in eRev
- Standardized reports in the process
- Procedural documentation as the basis for internal accreditation

Substantively described quality areas for Criteria of the StudAkkVO and the S+L Mission Statement



System accreditation:  
Quality areas address all subject-specific criteria according to the StudAkkVO, and are therefore consistent

But additional consideration is expected:

- Expanded review process
- Quality Report



# What do we hope to achieve?

Aligning measures and documentation with the benefits for program development

Flexibility (especially in terms of timing) when making changes to the program and the ability to flexibly implement new ideas regarding content (S+L Mission Statement)

Layering of exams and documentation reduces the workload for accreditation

Participation strengthens quality awareness and acceptance

Transparency through regular program-specific reports from the ZaQ to deans and the SGL
