

## **Reporting Requirements for System-Accredited Universities**

(Decision of the Accreditation Council dated September 24, 2018)

5 The entity responsible for entries in the database of accredited degree programs should be institution that makes the decision regarding the accreditation of a degree program or a quality management system: the Accreditation Council in program and system accreditation, and the system-accredited institution for its own degree programs (see § 18(4), sentence 2 of the MRVO).

10 of the Accreditation Council. All information entered into the database is checked for factual accuracy and subsequently released to the public.

For all degree programs accredited under the institutional accreditation process, the following information should be included in each entry:

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- Deadlines for program accreditation,
  - Type of accreditation (initial accreditation, reaccreditation, provisional accreditation, extension of deadline, other),
  - a brief profile of the program, including basic data contained in the Accreditation Council's reporting template for all types of procedures,<sup>1</sup>

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  - a summary evaluation,
  - a description of the process for awarding the seal (including information on the frequency of internal program accreditations at the institution),
  - a quality report,
  - information on the involvement of external reviewers<sup>2</sup> as well as, if specified in the QM system

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  - system of the institution, information on the conditions imposed (including details on the fulfillment of these conditions).

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<sup>1</sup> For the entry of basic data on the individual degree programs, corresponding mandatory fields (with predefined formats) are provided in the digital application processing system to be established by the Accreditation Council.
